Club career Zhang Junmin started his football career at third-tier club Guizhou Zhicheng in 2008. On 4 April 2011, he made his debut for Guizhou in the 2011 China League Two against Xinjiang Tianshan Leopard and came on as a substitute for Bao Daoyong in the 78th minute. His debut was not official though, as he was named among the squad in the first team's game against Qingdao Jonoon in a 0–0 draw on 15 July 2011. He would eventually make his first league start for the club in the next game on 30 July, coming on as a substitute for Zhang Zhixiang in the 76th minute, where he would then score the fourth goal for the club in the 86th minute in a 4–0 win over Hangzhou Greentown. He then scored his second goal for the club on 4 September 2011 when he came on as a substitute for Li Yaxin in the 84th minute, as Guizhou won the game 2–0 against Yanbian Funde. However, in the new season, he was not listed in the squad list and has remained in the reserve team. He also played for China League One club Shenyang Dongjin during the 2016 season.
